DOMImplementation Interface

The `<dfn>DOMImplementation interface</dfn>` provides methods to create documents and determine whether or not specified features are available in a particular implementation of the DOM APIs.

DOM Interface Methods	
boolean	<p>document.implementation.hasFeature(DOMString <i>feature</i>, DOMString <i>version</i>)</p> <p>Determines whether the DOM implementation supports a specific feature.</p> <p>Parameters:</p> <p><i>feature</i> - <i>version</i> -</p> <p>Returns:</p> <p><code>true</code> if the feature is implemented in the specified version or <code>false</code> if not</p>
DOMObject	<p>document.implementation.getFeature(DOMString <i>feature</i>, DOMString <i>version</i>)</p> <p>Parameters:</p> <p><i>feature</i> - <i>version</i> -</p> <p>Returns:</p> <p>-</p>
DocumentType	<p>document.implementation.createDocumentType(DocumentType <i>qualifiedName</i>, DOMString <i>publicId</i>,</p>

	<p>DOMString <i>systemId</i>) raises (DOMException)</p> <p>Creates an empty DocumentType node. For HTML 5, the <code>publicId</code> and <code>systemId</code> should both be <code>null</code>.</p> <p>Parameters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-- <p>Returns:</p> <p>a new DocumentType node</p>
Document	<p><code>document.implementation.createDocument(DOMString <i>namespaceURI</i>, DOMString <i>qualifiedName</i>, DocumentType <i>doctype</i>)</code> raises (DOMException)</p> <p>Parameters:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-- <p>Returns:</p> <p>a new Document object with its document element</p>
