### DOMImplementation Interface

The `<dfn>DOMImplementation interface</dfn>` provides methods to create documents and determine whether or not specified features are available in a particular implementation of the DOM APIs.

DOM Interface Methods	
boolean	<p><code>document.implementation.hasFeature(<a href="#">DOMString feature</a>, <a href="#">DOMString version</a>)</code></p> <p>Determines whether the DOM implementation supports a specific feature.</p> <p><b>Parameters:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>feature</i> -</li> <li><i>version</i> -</li> </ul> <p><b>Returns:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><code>true</code> if the feature is implemented in the specified version or <code>false</code> if not</li> </ul>
<a href="#">DOMObject</a>	<p><code>document.implementation.getFeature(<a href="#">DOMString feature</a>, <a href="#">DOMString version</a>)</code></p> <p><b>Parameters:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><i>feature</i> -</li> <li><i>version</i> -</li> </ul> <p><b>Returns:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-</li> </ul>
<a href="#">DocumentType</a>	<p><code>document.implementation.createDocumentType(<a href="#">DOMString qualifiedName</a>, <a href="#">DOMString publicId</a>,</code></p>

**[DOMString systemId](#) raises  
([DOMException](#))**

Creates an empty [DocumentType](#) node. For HTML 5, the publicId and systemId should both be `null`.

**[Document](#)**

`document.implementation.createDocument(DOMString namespaceURI, DOMString qualifiedName, DocumentType doctype)  
raises (DOMException)`
