## Microdata for Ratings

### Microdata for Ratings

#### Syntax

#### Examples

Since the value of the rating in the [h1 heading tag](#) applies to *all* of the [li list items](#) in the [section](#), the section is a microdata item that gets its value from the `itemprop="value"` attribute on the [heading tag](#). As above, the default scale with a range from 1 to 5 is used, where 5 is the best rating.

In this example, the `rating` microdata item has a second `itemprop="best"` property indicating that the range of ratings is from 1 to 10, with 10 being the best rating.
